## Everyone should have enough to eat.

Nourishing food is essential for people to grow, study, work and thrive in our communities. The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) is the nation's most effective food security program, and the first line of defense against hunger for 1 in 8 Mainers.

SNAP also supports our local economies: In 2024, more than \$684,000 went directly to Maine farmers from SNAP purchases at farmer's markets, keeping those dollars local and supporting rural economies.

But as part of their Project 2025 agenda, Donald Trump and his allies want to make massive cuts to SNAP, taking food away from seniors, families, and working Mainers with low incomes, so they can give tax breaks to the richest people in America.

These cuts to SNAP would devastate Maine families, local economies, and our state's efforts to end hunger and poverty.
